Four-Day Visit to the Field

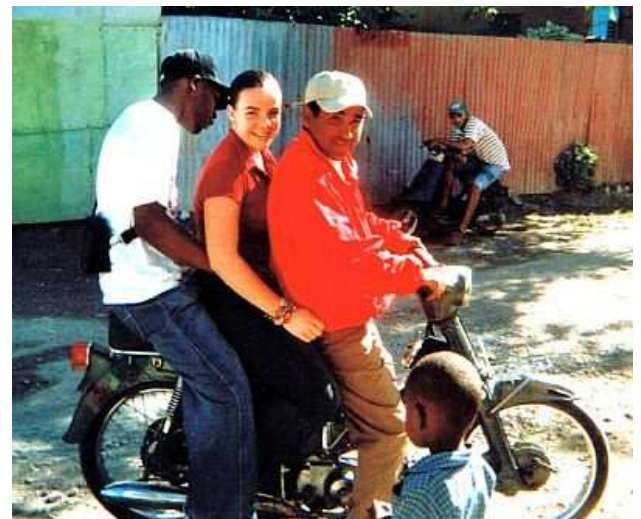

You probably know that we are home from the field, again between missionary assignments and busy with itineration and fund-raising. But Tim was asked by Area Director, Dale Coad, to make a visit to the field to meet with national church leaders. The purpose of this was to discuss how we can effectively partner together to further the growth of God's Kingdom among these islands but also to be approved for ministry. P.A.W.I. (the Pentecostal Association of the West Indies) must now pre-approve any missionaries coming to work within their territories, and we must also hold credentials with PAWI as well as with the U.S. Assemblies of God. It was great to meet the key people that I will be working with, and to get a preliminary first-hand view of the needs and opportunities in Antigua and Barbuda, and also to consider vision for ministry in the surrounding islands as well. The primary ministry is the church-planting work among the Spanish-speaking community in these islands. There is also a need for a school. We plan to bring in the services of Latin America ChildCare to help with the needs of those who are more poor and disadvantaged. There are plans to construct new church buildings as well as finish some that have been started but ran short of resources to finish the task. For this we hope to bring in teams from the States to help with labor. Teams can also be involved in outreach and ministry as well. There will be leadership development and training of workers, so eventually we hope to have a full-fledged Bible school up-and-running. P.A.W.I. is just now getting into media ministries such as television and radio, so there may be opportunities there as well. As you can see, there is no shortage of vision and the possibilities are great. We thank God for what He is doing in the earth today. It is awesome to realize that we all have a part in it!
