What is Latin America ChildCare???



Latin America ChildCare [lacc4hope.org] is a school-based way of reaching out to the Latino children of South America, Central America, Mexico, and the Caribbean – of whom more than 50% grow up in poverty.

In addition to education the children get healthy meals and receive medical screenings and attention. Most importantly they're exposed to the Gospel and brought up in an environment of Christian love and nurture.

In St. John's we will be partnering with *the Pentecostal Assemblies of the West Indies* [[website: PAWIONLINE.ORG](http://www.pawionline.org)] – and with the immigrant Latino community themselves to help bring about the establishment of an LACC school. Currently there is no school at all for the Spanish speaking children of Antigua. We will be the only A/G missionary personnel in those northern Leeward Islands. Of reaching a new immigrant population, Area Director Dale Coad states "the greatest challenge facing us in the Caribbean is how to respond to the influx of immigrants from the surrounding nations. In Antigua, Nevis and St. Kitts, there has been a surge of Spanish speaking immigrants. The English speaking churches there are not equipped to reach the immigrants and are pleading for assistance ... **It**

has been proven that the greatest response in the immigrant population to the Gospel takes place within the first 6 months in the new culture. Many people had strong community ties and a traditional church background in their old culture that prohibited them from fully embracing the salvation message. When Spirit-filled believers befriend them in their new culture and present the Good News, many respond with total abandonment to their newly found Savior ... The leaders of PAWI committed themselves to pray ... to be able to take advantage of this historic onslaught of displaced people who by every definition of the term are 'an unreached people group'..."
